





Monica Melanchthon is Professor of Old Testament and one of the leading Dalit Woman-Theologians. She will be adressing issues of scripture reading in interreligious dialogue and women in religions.



Prof. Melanchthon has strong commitments to the marginalized, particularly, women and Dalits. She has contributed toward developing Dalit and Indian Feminist hermeneutics and theologies, and interpretation of Biblical texts drawing on insights from the social biographies of these communities, their perspectives and their lived experiences. Her approach is therefore contextual, inter disciplinary and liberational. Her research interests include cultural and literary studies, reception histories, epistemologies, ecological readings, feminist hermeneutics and interpretations.
