The Sars 2 virus in the ongoing pandemic reveals exciting insights in political and moral pathologies as well as in new potentials and challenges for our common sustainable future. The talk will try to map the complex agenda of ethical and cultural problems in this context, and offer some preliminary suggestions of what we might be able to learn from this pandemic. I will pend between observations in the schmozzle of the national disaster in Sweden's Sonderweg and more general reflections about culture, politics, ethics and worldviews, departing from the WHO's four criteria for a pandemic ethics: transparancy, universalisation, participation and accountability.
