Dr. Jude Lal Fernando, Associate Professor
Irish School of Ecumenics

Wars are waged claiming to guarantee peace and security. This lecture raises the questions: whose peace? whose security? Prof. Fernando will problematize imperial peace in biblical, theological, interreligious and political terms in seeking just peace that guarantees life, life in abundance.

Jude Lal Fernando is an Associate Professor of Ecumenics and Coordinator of the MPhil in Contextual Theologies and Interfaith Relations Programme and MPhil in International Peace Studies Programme at the School of Religion, Theology, and Peace Studies in Trinity College Dublin. His most recent publications include the two edited collections *Resistance to Empire and Militarisation: Reclaiming the Sacred* (2020) and *Faith in the Face of Militarization* (2021); he is the coordinator of the Peoples' Tribunal on Sri Lanka (Dublin, 2010; Bremen, 2013; Berlin 2022).
