Minjung (ordinary oppressed people) in Korean history are the people who aspire to live in equality and freedom. But they are confined within an oppressive system created by the existing neo-liberal and undemocratic politico-economic system in Korea. There are on-going conflicts and clashes between the current system and the proactive minjung in Korea. The lecture will look into the relation of subject and body, in and of minjung in these conflicts.
